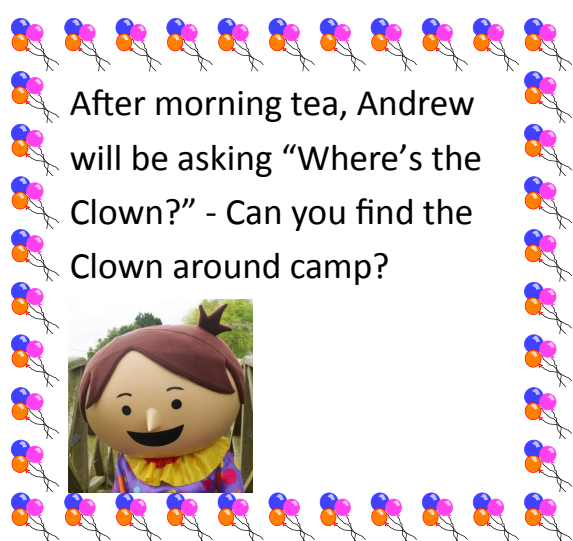




# Thursday 28th December 2017

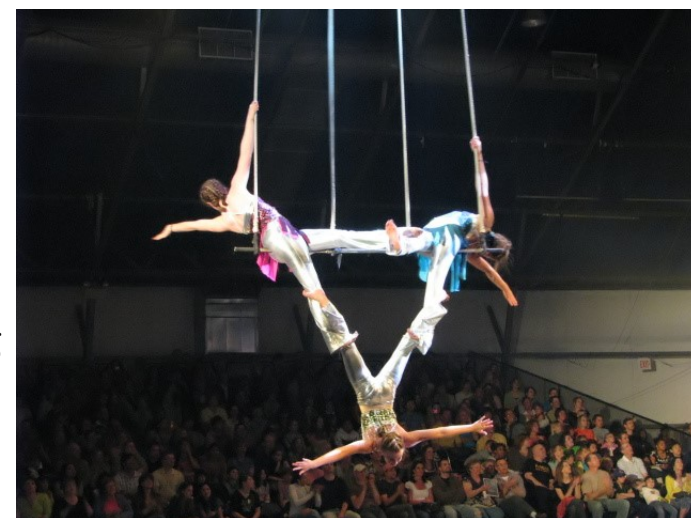
## Highlights for today

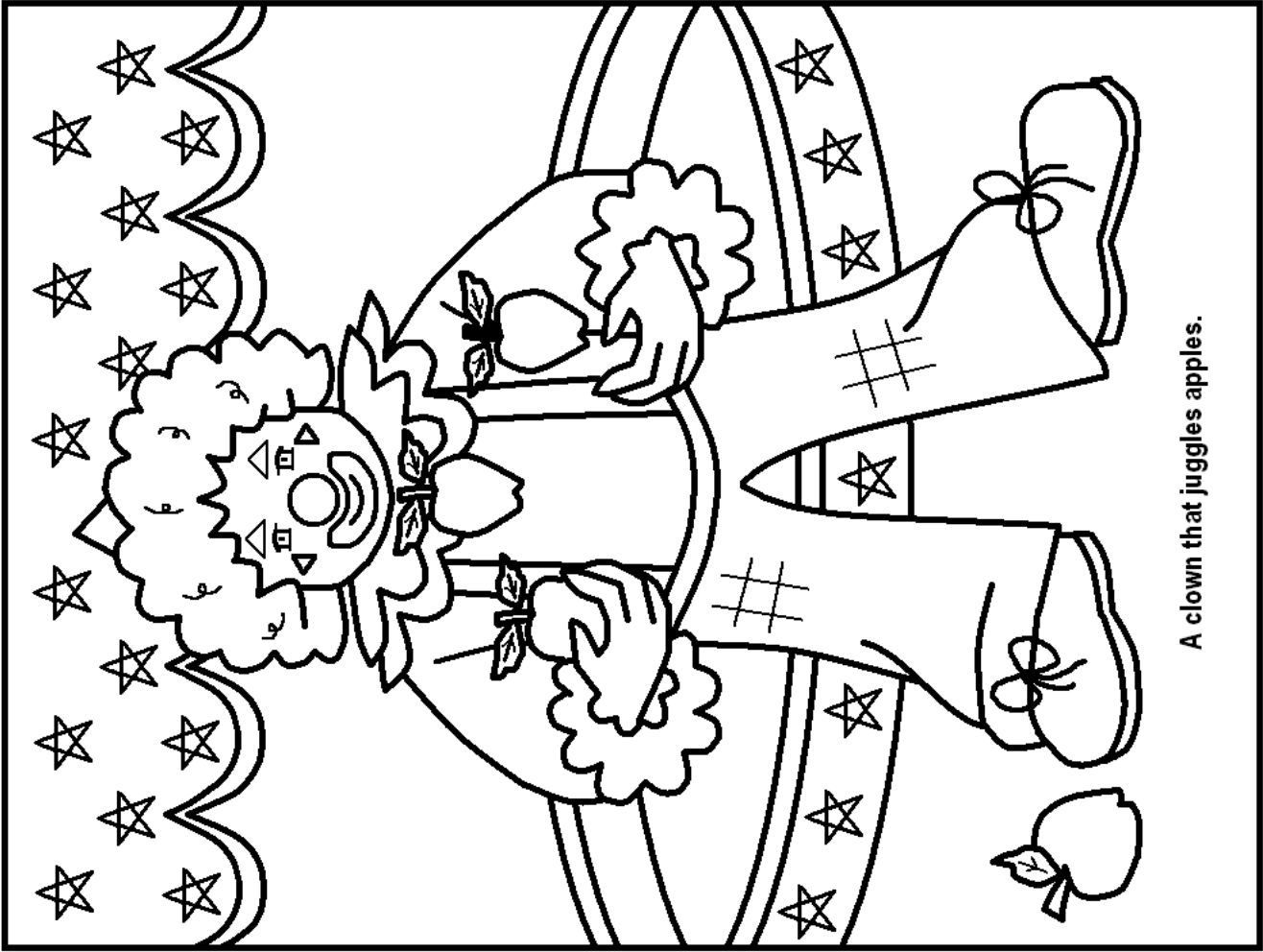
Daily Puzzles and colouring in

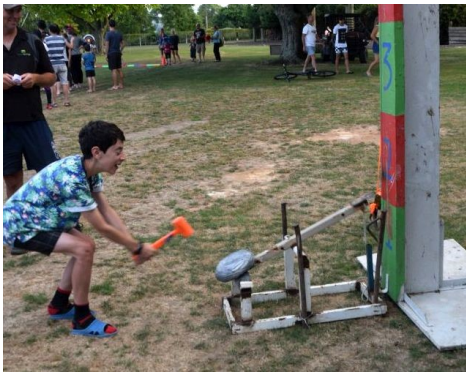
