SAFETY ACTION PLAN

	- Submerged object	- Pre-check river for hazards and correct depth	TSCC	
Bumps, bruises, scrapes, strains, sprains	- Uneven/slippy surface - Fallen foliage creating slippy surface - Slippy thin bridge - Hitting T-bar - Whiplash	- Wear appropriate footwear - Remove overhanging branches and clear track - Support unconfident students on bridge - Head to one side when riding T-Bar - 90kg weight limit	Group leaders TS instructor Participants TS instructor	During Prior to setup + Monthly inspection During
Equipment damage	- Exceeding weight limit	- Participants should weigh less than 90kg	TS instructor	During
Exposure to elements (sun, wind, temperature)	- Long periods out in the sun, river wind and rain without correct clothes	- Move to an indoor activity during "bad weather" - Ensure the group has adequate clothing	TS instructor Participants + Group leaders	Before Before & During
