	- Not physically appropriate for the team	- Ensure the team is physically capable of the challenges	Group Leaders	During	
	- Negative comments by bystanders	- Give guidelines to bystanders regarding opinions	TS Instructors	During	
Bumps, bruises, scrapes, strains, sprains	- Falling off an element - Poor Supervision - Team mates not "spotting" properly	- Use the acronym S.O.S "step off safely" when describing how to dismount the element - Brief participants on the importance of spotting and how to spot	Participants + Group leaders	Before	<i>Entrapment</i> - Instructor to follow procedure to release trapped item <i>Other/ Minor Injury</i> - Group leader to administer first aid
	- Running with socks on carpet	- No Running in socks	Group leader	During	
	- Holding broom handle at head height - Throwing objects - Draping rope around neck	- Clear brief about use of equipment, including being aware of group members, the length of the broom handle, and the risks of carrying rope around their neck	Participants + Group leaders	Before & During
