Death/Serious Injury (Hit by axe)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Inadequate instruction - Failure to follow instruction - Bystanders in front of thrower - Throwers throwing axes in direction of bystanders 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Instructors are suitably qualified - Clear instructions are given - Listen attentively and follow instructions - Position targets so no one will walk behind them - Everyone must be standing or seated behind Throwers - No one is to go past the Thrower until all axes are thrown - Throw the axes towards clear targets at all times - Facilitator to stand behind the thrower 	TSCC TS instructor Participants + Group Leaders Group Leaders Group Leaders Participants + Group Leaders	Before Before Beginning & During During During	<i>Suspected major injury</i> - All to vacate area - Group leader to coordinate first aid - Group leader to arrange for ambulance or extra assistance - Inform host of incident immediately and fill out appropriate forms - Assess if activity can continue

Equipment Damage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gear getting left out - Dropping axe. - Incorrect axe removal. - Target deterioration. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Put away at the end of the day. - Correct maintenance after use. - Clear instructions/demonstration of technique. - Monitor and perform maintenance as required. 	TS instructor Group leader Participants + Group leaders	Before After During	<i>Other/ Minor Injury</i> - Group leader to administer first aid
Exposure to elements (sun, wind, temperature)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Long periods out in the sun or wind and rain without correct clothes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Move to an indoor Activity during “bad weather” - Ensure the group has adequate clothing 	TS instructor Participants + Group leaders	Before Before & During
