Impact Injury (Water, surface, river bed, or other person)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Submerged object, e.g. sticks, debris - Shallow water - Swimmer(s) in landing area - Inappropriate entry to water - Failure to apply instructions given re: slide use, water entry 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pre-check river for hazards and correct depth - Exit river ASAP, no swimming below slide - Land bottom first- feet and head up - Listen attentively and follow instructions 	Group Leader Group Leader Participants + Group leaders	Before During During	<i>Entrapment</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Group Leader to release trapped item
