Tōtara Springs Christian Centre is New Zealand's ultimate venue for church retreats, school camps, conferences, events and more.

Now in its sixth decade and still highly popular, some areas are tired, run-down, and in need of an upgrade to support further growth. Built in the late sixties, the original cabins received an extension a few years ago. However, they are now outdated and no longer suitable for their intended purpose.

Given the age of the current structures, ongoing maintenance, and the need for additions to comply with new building codes, our new project stands out as the most cost-effective solution for the centre.


Through a master-planning process, TSCC aims to replace and enhance several key facilities.


MAKING A MASTERPLAN

TSCC engaged MAKE Architects to develop our masterplan.
The concept design is of a new multi-wing cabin block, with cabins connected by open air covered walkways around sheltered green courtyard spaces.

- 4 separate cabin wings providing 288 beds.
- Central shared ablution facilities (32 showers + toilets in total)
- Towel drying rooms
- 4 separate Parent/Teacher rooms with en-suite facilities, providing up to 24 extra beds.

Since 1967, tens of thousands have experienced these cabins, our most utilized accommodation. Upgrading infrastructure, including water storage and wastewater systems as we go, will pave the way for future growth at TSCC.

YOU CAN HELP US CREATE

a vibrant new complex

The new cabin complex will be built on the current football field, and will replace the existing 220 bed Rata & Manuka cabins, making a total of 312 beds. Once complete, the old cabins will be demolished or repurposed.

36 SHOWERS

PROPOSED REDS

4 BLOCKS OF CABIN ACCOMMODATION

Each separate block consists of two separated building rows of 3 bunk rooms each, typically 12 beds per room with storage and changing area per cabin.

That's 24 new rooms with 288 beds.

2 BLOCKS OF TEACHER/FAMILY ACCOMMODATION


These will be 2 separate blocks, 2 rooms each, with en-suite facilities, typically 4 beds per room (max. 6 beds per room). Total of 4 new rooms with up to 24 beds.

ABLUTION FACILITIES + TOWEL DRYING ROOMS

Four blocks, each with 8 toilets and 8 showers- that's 32 facilities, including accessibility features. Additionally, 4 en-suite facilities are designated for Teacher cabins. Overall, a total for showers and toilets is 36, maintaining a ratio of 1:9 facility per campers.

COVERED WALKWAYS

The walkways will link the cabin complex facilities and future connection to the proposed Meeting Hall and Bus bay.







We're on a mission to create accessible spaces to serve our guests & connect them during their stay.

A parking lot for around 50 vehicles, including accessible spaces, will be located east of the complex. In tandem with the Cabin Complex Project, vital infrastructure enhancements include a new water main, upgraded wastewater septic tanks and pump stations, and stormwater improvements to align with the master plan for future projects.
